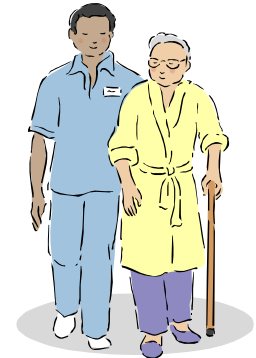

## Become a Certified Nursing Assistant

- High demand job - No academic prerequisites
- Local and long-term opportunities
- Rewarding and challenging work
- Receive cost reimbursement if hired within one year (by a Medicare/Medicaid approved employer)



This training prepares students for careers in healthcare under the supervision of a licensed nurse. Curriculum includes First Aid and CPR training, providing or assisting in client care, bathing, dressing, grooming, toileting, ambulation, transferring, feeding, use of equipment, documenting and reporting the general well-being of the client. Theory and clinical study will provide necessary information and skills needed in long-term, home-care, and acute care settings and to take the Montana Department of Health State Competency CNA Evaluation Examination. A full 100 hours of instruction is included; offered in two locations.

**COST: \$800, includes textbook, CPR/First Aid fee, supplies, and State Exam fee**
